# **OTHER CAMPUS RESOURCES**

As of May 1, 2021, the Auraria Campus Police Department (ACPD) introduced a Co-Responder Model, which pairs law enforcement and behavioral health specialists to intervene and respond to behavioral health-related calls for police service. Through an agreement with the Mental Health Center of Denver, a campus-designated social worker will work with the Department to respond to behavioral health-related situations. The Auraria Campus Police officer and the behavioral health specialist will de-escalate situations together and connect individuals in need of appropriate services to best support behavioral health calls.

If there is an immediate threat to a student, either through self-harm or interpersonal violence, or to the broader campus community, please call or text the ACPD or dial 911 from a campus phone.
