- Guest Speaker:
 - Maly Mendieta – CCD Vice President
Maly stated that last year CCD started on a project called Open Source Textbooks where students would be able to get access to certain textbooks online and then have the option to print them for free. However, it was also

noted that the project was put on hold due to difficulties that were encountered. Frida asked about student accessibility to the service and Maly responded that she and her constituents have been working with every department to provide this service to all students, but first they would like to concentrate efforts on a single class to ensure program stability. CCD will continue to look at this initiative and see if they can make it successful this year. Bela thought this was a good idea. Maly will also be receiving information about AHHA week, in hopes that they will want to participate in this event, along with SACAB this year. Safety is on the radar for CCD SGA this year, however Maly hasn't heard any complaints from CCD students about campus.

New Business

a. New SACAB Logo

Starting last year, SACAB was looking for a refresh to their current image. Permission was granted on the one caveat that the tri-institutional vibe needs to be upheld. Fonts and changes can still be made to the existing submissions and the color for the shirts and swag will be decided later.

1st Logo: This is the least liked design, it also encounters the issue of it being difficult to embroider due to the three-tone design of the lettering.

2nd Logo: The most liked design by far, though it was not without criticism. Emily dislikes the spacing, it was also described as being very cooperate looking. Frida proposed the idea of triangles instead of circles, Emily seconded. Christie brought up the idea of the triangles looking like mountains to signify Colorado. It was also decided that adjustments to the font needed to happen, but the letters should maintain their capitalization.

3rd Logo: This design is a refresh of current logo, though the font was criticized for being too simple.

b. Update Smoking Pamphlets

The date of the pamphlets will be updated and a couple of the locations themselves were very slightly moved, as they were too close to an air intake. SACAB purchased the first round of smoking maps, and AHEC is asking if they would like to continue this. They will be helpful to hand out to offices and tabling events such as Student Welcome Week. The total amount for a reprint would be \$467 dollars for 2000 maps.

Frida called for a motion to approve the aforementioned amount of \$467 for the purpose of reprinting the smoking zone amps. **Emily moved and Bela seconded. The motion passed unanimously.**

The group thought that changing the color might also be made to indicate the change in the pamphlets; Emily thought they should use an assertive color. Frida thought green might work as it corresponds to the green initiative. Ariel will distribute the proof

of the updated maps to the group. Additionally, she will contact marketing regarding the color change and find out the options.

c. Office Supply Budget

Frida called for a motion to allocate a total not to exceed \$45 for the office supply budget. **Mayra moved and Emily seconded. The motion passed unanimously.**

d. Grand Opening Logistics – Sigi’s Hub

September 13th will be the grand opening for Sigi’s Hub. Setup will begin at 12:00 and at 12:30PM the ribbon cutting ceremony will commence and last until about 2:00pm. Students will also be directed to the newly renovated Garage Lounge.

As for what food, the group thinks they will order Blackjack pizza; enough for 100 people, which comes out to be about 20 boxes of pizza.

Ariel might have supplies left over from a different ribbon cutting but the budget of the grand opening will be held off until next week. A pair of giant scissors is already in the office. Social media will also be used to spread the word.
