Re: Auraria Campus Shade Garden Signage and Benches Funding

Description

The proposal focuses on the development of a shade garden located outside the Plaza Building on 10th Street Plaza between Lawrence St. and Larimer St. on Auraria campus. Shade gardens are known to reduce solar heat-gain in a garden and in surrounding areas. Shade gardens that are established with plant species native to Colorado can help retain soil irrigation, provide critical habitat for wildlife and pollinator species, and provide a place for students and staff to not only find respite from the heat, but also impart an educational opportunity.

This budget proposal differs from the original Shade Garden project proposal in that we are asking SACAB to allocate \$4,100.00 in funds for the purchasing of three metal benches with plaque inserts, as well as purchasing for signage. Each bench is estimated to cost roughly \$1,200.00, and materials for creating signage for the garden is estimated at \$500.00.
